What's happening in Sheffield? Spotlight on...



Dr Mo Thoufeeq is a consultant gastroenterologist with an interest in GI endoscopy in Sheffield, United Kingdom.

He is a BSG enthusiast and has always been keen on delivering clinical work, research, and training internationally. He is part of the BSG's executive team and is the current chair of BSG's international committee. Having written the most recent BSG's international strategy, he oversees it.

He has run endoscopy courses in Malta, Cairo, and India (these include basic skills courses, train the trainers and haemostasis course).

In 2023, he was recently awarded 'international professorship' by Prof Pratap Reddy, Chairman of Apollo Hospitals, India which is the largest healthcare provider in South Asia.

In May 2024, he organised the 1st ever BSG international affiliated conference in the United Arab Emirates which was attended by over 300 delegates.

Over the last year, as part of the BSG international work, he ran 4 upper GI bleeding haemostasis courses and GI bleeding symposia in India which was

attended by over 200 clinicians.

He has trained and mentored endoscopists from abroad who have delivered several service lists and clinical research projects in Sheffield. There are collaborative clinical activities still taking place with them once they have returned to their homeland. He is a firm believer in 'giving back' to the world and in helping to reduce variation in practice, inequalities and improving clinical care.



Dr Hey Ching has recently been appointed director of the Sheffield Endoscopy Training Centre and the South Yorkshire Immersion Centre Lead for the Yorkshire Endoscopy Training Academy (YETA). Endoscopy training academies across the nation are part of the NHSE collaboration to optimise the provision of endoscopy training, taking into account local challenges and opportunities. Each immersion centre is responsible for the immersive training of Gastroenterology Registrars, Clinical Endoscopists and Surgical trainees. Immersive training is a set period of time (total of 4 weeks) when the trainee will have an intensive block (5 to 6 lists per week) of either colonoscopy or gastroscopy training lists.

The Bardhan Lecture



This year's Bardhan Lecture will be delivered by Professor Jeanin van Hooft who is a consultant gastroenterologist and Chair of the Department of Gastroenterology and Hepatology at the Leiden University Medical Centre, Leiden.

Professor Van Hooft is a specialist in interventional endoscopy, in particular hepato-pancreatico-biliary interventions.

Since 2009 she has been leading a research group with a strong focus on pancreatic diseases and in part on endoscopic treatment of gastrointestinal strictures. Dr. Van Hooft has authored and co-authored over 300 peer reviewed publications and textbook chapters and has lectured at more than 200 national and international meetings. In 2016 she obtained her Master of Business Administration (MBA) degree at the Amsterdam Business School, University of Amsterdam (Triple Crown accredited). She has been the chair of the ESGE guideline committee from 2016-2021 and is currently the secretary general of the UEG. Furthermore, she is a member of the board of Women in Endoscopy (WIE) and on National level she is active as member (treasurer) of the Pancreatitis Working group of the Netherlands (PWN) and member of the research board of the Dutch Pancreatic Cancer group (DPCG).

Sheffield have been the recipients of **11 Clinical Service Awards (10 national and 1 international) and 9 Clinical Research Awards (6 National & 3 International)** in the last 20 years. We're the only department in the UK to have won the BSG Hopkins Endoscopy prize three times, 2012, 2017 & 2019. Also more recently we are a **World Endoscopy Organisation Centre of Excellence (www.worldendo.org/about-us/center-of-excellence)**. There are only **20 recognised centres globally**. The selection is through open competition and application. In the UK only **2 centres currently hold this award**.

Our areas of interest are diverse, covering all aspects of luminal gastroenterology and endoscopy. Tell us what you want to do and we will accommodate you.
